Get to Know Peter Sandeen a Little Bit More

- ✓ Sandeen started as a copywriter.
- ✓ After he had done that for a while, he started to think 'maybe I should get into conversion optimization and maybe learn other stuff as well leading to conversion optimization' and he went into that.

Greatest Challenge for Sandeen and Overcoming It

- ✓ According to Sandeen, the biggest challenge had been in his head, like personal beliefs around success and all these different things.
- ✓ The first thing to do is list the limiting beliefs, then argue with it, and then replace it with another belief and continue that until you believe in the new belief.

Recommendations and Tips for Entrepreneurs

- ✓ Focus. Focus about what you do, who you serve, what your strategies/tactics are like, what you should spend your time on, what you should use.
- ✓ There are two categories:
 - \checkmark The first is lack of focus which leads to trying too many things.
 - ✓ The second is lack of focus on what you are really trying to make people believe, see and understand about you.
- ✓ There are three things you should look at:
 - ✓ First: how much do people actually want that thing that you're talking about?
 - \checkmark Second: how unique it is.
 - \checkmark Third: how believable the idea is.
